# RULES & INFORMATION

---

- Each dancer can compete in 1 group per style therefore a dancer could dance in up to 6 different routines plus Commercial trio/quads.
- Each group must have a minimum of 5 dancers & maximum of 25 (the floor size will be approximately 13m (wide) x 12m (depth)).
- Age categories are 8 & Under, 12 & Under, 16 & Under and 17 & Over.
- Each dancer can compete in either a commercial trio or quad, not both and all dancers must be the age of below, for example if one dancer in the trio/quad is 9 and the rest are 8 they must compete in 12 & Under and so on.
- Music length for groups can be a maximum of 2 minutes for beginners groups & 2 minute 30 seconds for advanced groups, there is no minimum length and music must be emailed over at least 14 days before the event.
- Groups are not permitted to use obscene language during their routines.
- Each crew must have a minimum of 75% of its dancers in the age division they have entered, 25% of dancers may be 1 age division higher.

For example, if a crew who is competing in 12 & Under have 12 members, 9 of the members (75%) must be 12 or under the other 3 members (25%) can be either 13, 14 or 15, none of its members can be 16 or over.

- Props are permitted; however, you must be able to clear them immediately after your performance therefore glitter, water etc must not be used.
- Only teachers or school officials should approach the event staff with questions during the competition. Event staff can be identified by their uniform.
- Costumes and dance moves performed should be appropriate for all age groups and should not include any inappropriate, sexual, or explicit movements.
- These rules may be changed without notice, and an updated copy will be emailed to the school principal at least 12 weeks before the event.
- Time 2 Shine is an event which focuses on creating a positive environment for everyone while providing a fun and friendly event. We encourage all dancers and spectators to support all competitors and maintain a good level of sportsmanship between one another.
